III. OPERATION

1. Basic Operations

1.1 Answer a call

11. TMENU Key

12. **∧** UP Key

When a call from the Camera is in progress, you can press the Talk Key

(i) to start a talking. To end, simply press the Talk Key again. (i) To refuse the call, press corresponding Monitor Key.

1.2 Monitor

When the Indoor Monitor is in the standby mode, press Monitor Key 1 (($\underline{\mathbf{R}}$) / Monitor Key 2 (($\underline{\mathbf{R}}$) to monitor Camera.

To launch a talk during the monitoring, press the Talk Key ((s)). To end the monitoring, press corresponding Monitor Key.

1.3 Remote Door Release

When a call is in progress with the Outdoor Camera: you can press the Open Key to open the door(\bigcirc) (Electric lock is an option only)

1.4 Capture a picture manually

During monitoring, press Snap Key ((a)) to capture a picture.

1.5 Adjusting the talk volume

You may turn the Talk Volume Control Knob (see Fig.4) counterclockwise / clockwise to turn up/down the volume.

1.6 Adjust video brightness

When a call or a talk or surveillance is in progress, press the MENU Key (\Box) to access the settings of brightness, and then press the UP (\land) or DOWN (\lor) Key to adjust it. (16 levels)

1.7 Select a ringtone

You may choose a ringtone by pressing the UP (\land) or DOWN (\lor) Key when the Indoor Phone is in the standby mode. (9 ringtones)

2. Settings

Press and hold MENU Key ($rac{1}$) for 6 seconds to access the Settings menu (Fig.5).

2.1 () Ringing Volume

Press () on the Settings menu. (ringing volume: 8 levels)

- a) press (a) to turn up the volume
- b) press \mathbf{A} to turn down the volume
- c) press < _ to save the settings and return to the Settings menu

2.2 🖻 Auto Capture

Press 🗐 on the Settings menu.

- a) press $\square N$ to activate auto capture function
- b) press **DFF** to deactivate auto capture function
- c) press (to save the settings and return to the Settings menu

2.3 () Time Settings

Press () on the Settings menu.

- a) press 🛄 to locate an item (year/month/day/hour/minute)
- b) press + to increase the value
- b) press to decrease the value
- c) press \leftarrow to save the settings and return to the Settings menu

2.4 🗹 Restore

Press 🗹 on the Settings menu.

a) press \checkmark to restore the factory settings (*after the operation, all pictures stored will be removed.)

b) press X to save the settings and return to the Settings menu 2.5 \leftarrow **Exit**

Press ← to exit the Settings menu and return to the standby mode.

3. Intercom

When a visitor presses the Call Button on Outdoor Camera, the Indoor Phone rings and displays the visitor's image. Meanwhile, the visitor can hear the ring back tone. (call time: 90s)

- a) capture a picture of the screen: press Snap Key ((a))
- b) Press the talk (i) to start talking (talk time: 60s)
- c) release the door remotely during a call: press the Open Key

(-) to open the door

- d) end a talk: press the Talk Key (🕢) a second time
- e) refuse a call: corresponding Monitor Key

4. Surveillance

When the Indoor Phone is in the standby mode, you may press the Monitor Key 1 ($(\widehat{\mathbf{n}})$) /Monitor Key 2 ($(\widehat{\mathbf{n}})$) to monitor the doorway 1/

or doorway 2. (monitor time: 60s)

- a) capture a picture of the screen: press Snap Key ((a))
- b) start a talk (talk time:60s): press the Talk Key ((i)) on the panel
- c) release the door remotely: press the Open Key (🕣) to open the door
- d) end the monitoring: press the corresponding Monitor Key

5. View Captured Pictures

Press Snap Key ((a)) when the device is stand by to access the Capture viewing screen.

5.1 View the pictures captured automatically

Press $\boxed{8}$ on the Capture viewing screen to access the auto capture screen (Fig.7) $1 \quad 2 \quad 3$





- 1) the time when the picture is taken
- 2) current picture/ total pictures
- 3) \bigcirc / \bigcirc : picture locked/unlocked
- 4) \triangle : display the previous picture
- 5) ∇ : display the next picture
- 6) **□ □** / **▷** : pause/play
- 7) 🔚 : enter the picture settings menu to lock/unlock/delete picture
 - a) \bigcap / \bigcap : lock/unlock the current picture
 - b) 💼 : delete the current picture if it is not locked up
- 8) : return to previous menu
- 9) order indicator: show the order of currently displayed picture in the group

*When a visitor call is not answered, a group of pictures (1-3 pieces) will be taken with the Outdoor Camera automatically if the auto capture function is activated.

memory capacity: 20 groups (latest)

Pictures locked will not be covered by the latest ones.

5.2 View the pictures captured manually

Press (2) on the Capture viewing screen to access the manual capture screen (Fig.8). 1 2 3





- 1) the time when the picture is taken
- 2) current picture/ total pictures
- 3) \square / \square : picture locked/unlocked
- 4) \triangle : display the previous picture
- 5) ∇ : display the next picture
- 6) $\square / \square^{\circ}$: lock/unlock the current picture
- 7) $\mathbf{\overline{m}}$: delete the current picture if it is not locked up

a) press \checkmark to confirm the deletion

b) press X to return to the previous menu

8) \leftarrow : return to the previous menu

*When a call from Outdoor Camera/ a talk with Outdoor Camera/ surveillance is in progress, you may take picture manually with the Outdoor Camera.

memory capacity: 50 pictures (latest)

Pictures locked will not be covered by the latest ones.

6. Other Features

Missed call warning

When a visitor call is not answered (if the Auto Capture function is activated), the backlight of touch-sensitive keys blinks.
